Ridden Ring Classes start 9.30am

1. **Tack and Turn Out** – LR Welcome
2. **Beginners Showing** – Junior – riders 16 years & under as of 1st January 2017
3. **Beginners Showing** – Senior – riders 17 years & over as of 1st January 2017
Classes 2 & 3 - (walk & trot only). Snaffle bridles only. Open to horses and ponies, riders any age. Lead rein riders are permitted to compete in this class off the lead rein – this is to encourage young riders in their transition from Lead Rein. They must remain on the lead rein for all other classes
4. **Ridden Hunter Horse or Pony**
5. **Equitation** – Junior, rider 16 years & under from 1st January 2017
6. **Equitation** – Senior, 17 years & over
7. **Ridden Showing** – Open to horses and ponies, any breed or type, LR welcome
8. **First Ridden** – rider 10 years & under
9. **Coloured Horse or Pony**
10. **Novice Showing Combination** – open to any age, breed or type, combination to be in their first season together
11. **Ridden Horse/ Hack**
12. **Ridden Pony** – n/e 14.2HH
13. **Ridden Cob** – to include hogged, traditional, coblett & maxi
14. **Ridden Mountain & Moorland** – LR welcome
15. **Ridden Veteran Horse & Pony** – aged 15 years and over - LR welcome

Ridden Championship – 1st and 2nd places from classes' 1 – 15 eligible

In Hand Ring Classes start 9.30am

All junior competitors and handlers must wear a hard hat at all times whilst leading ponies/horses
Our Club recommends that senior handlers wear a hard hat whilst leading ponies/horses

16. **Young Stock** – 3 years & under. Handler to be 12 years or older
17. **Best Conditioned**
18. **In Hand Mountain & Moorland** – will be split into small & large breeds if 12 entries or more
19. **Senior Handler** – 17 years & over
20. **Young Handler** – 16 years & under
21. **Bonnie Pony**
22. **In Hand Cob** – to include hogged, traditional, coblett & maxi
23. **In Hand Veteran**
24. **In Hand Hunter**
25. **In Hand Coloured Horse or Pony**
26. **In Hand Horse/Hack**

In Hand Championship – 1st and 2nd places from classes 16 – 26 eligible

35. **Best Riding Club Type** – Lead Rein
36. **Best Riding Club Type** – First Ridden, 10 years & under
37. **Best Riding Club Type** – 14.2HH and under
38. **Best Riding Club Type** – 14.3HH and over

These classes will include an individual show and 2 jumps/trotting poles

BRCT Championship – 1st and 2nd places from classes 35 – 38 eligible

Here's how the point system works... (for MDRC members)

- You will be awarded points for each class that you enter at a show that counts towards the 2017 Presentation.
- If you compete on more than one horse or pony, you will receive points per horse or pony.
- Your top 5 classes will be taken into account for the Club Supreme Champion. This will also be on a per horse or pony basis.

Points are awarded as follows:

- 1st = 8 points
- 2nd = 6 points
- 3rd = 4 points
- 4th = 2 points

In a case where a non member is placed higher than a MDRC member, the points will move down to the next placed MDRC member.

Please note that these rules are in addition to the Standard Rules operated by MDRC..
