The Maltby District Riding Club will be run in accordance with The British Riding Club rules. A full copy of our rules is available on the club website.

** First, second and third placed horses/ponies in eligible classes not already qualified will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show 2018. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. Ridden Classes approx 12pm start

- Class 11** **First Ridden *{*qualifier}***
Open to ponies of any type – riders 12 years and under. Age as of 1st Jan in current year
- Class 12** **Beginners Showing** (walk & trot only). Snaffle bridles only. Open to horses and ponies, riders any age. If sufficient entries the class will be split into seniors and juniors
- Class 13** **Lead Rein Ridden *{*qualifier}***
Open to ponies of any type – riders 8 years and under. Age as of 1st Jan in current year
- Class 14** **Ridden Mountain & Moorland (LR welcome) *{*qualifier}***
Large and small breeds, class will be split if there are sufficient entries
- Class 15** **Ridden Cob *{*qualifier}***
- Class 16** **Ridden Part Bred *{*qualifier}***
Open to horses and ponies – any breed or type
- Class 17** **New/Novice Combination**
Open to any age, breed or type. Combination to be in their first show season together
- Class 18** **Ridden Coloured *{*qualifier}***
Open to horses and ponies
- Class 19** **Ridden Hunter *{*qualifier}***
Open to horses and ponies
- Class 20** **Ridden Showing *{*qualifier}***
Open to horses and ponies – any breed or type
