**MDRC Members £5 per class**

**Non Members £8 per class**

*No cheques accepted on the day from Non Members*

***New Membership welcome on the day***

**Clear round will follow class 1 and run until 10.15am. Last entry 10am.**

**Class 1 will start at 9.15am prompt**

- Please note that prize money will be paid in classes 3, 8, 9 and 10 provided there are more than 10 competitors in each class at the discretion of the organisers.
- Competitors may only enter 3 consecutive height classes. This does not affect entries to classes 4 – 7
- Classes 5 & 6 are members only.

**Class 1 LR & Beginners – Maximum height 45cm**  
Open to horses and ponies, rider any age. A great starter class for all. LR & Beginners awarded separately. Competitors from class 1 are eligible for classes 2A and 2B only.

**CLEAR ROUND** to follow class 1 finishing at 10.15am. Last entry 10am

**Class 2**  
**A 55cm Ponies**  
**B 55cm Horses**

**Class 3**  
**A 65cm Ponies**  
**B 65cm Horses**

**Class 4**  
**Pairs Maximum height 75cm**  
£10 per pair

**Class 5 Bob Robinson Trophy Class (Ponies)**  
This class is free to enter for our members and is a season long class with a lovely trophy presented to the overall winner at presentation evening

**Class 6 Baron Trophy Class (Horses)**  
This class is free to enter for our members and is a season long class with a lovely trophy presented to the overall winner at presentation evening

**Class 7**  
**A Speed Class - Ponies**  
**B Speed Class – Horses**  
One round against the clock, starting at 60cm with a maximum height of 80cm. Time penalties are added for any fence down  
  
MDRC members competing in class 7 will be competing for the MDRC Fastest Pony of the Year, and MDRC Fastest Horse of the Year – both awards will be made at the 2019 Presentation Evening.

**Class 8**  
**A 75cm Ponies**  
**B 75cm Horses**

**Class 9**  
**A 85cm Ponies**  
**B 85cm Horses**

**Class 10**  
**A 95cm Ponies**  
**B 95cm Horses**

**All jumping rounds will be timed and only competitors that jump clear will go into a timed jump off round.**

**All other places will be awarded by faults and times.**

**Here's how the point system works... (for MDRC members)**

- You will be awarded points for each class that you enter at a show that counts towards the 2019 Presentation.
- If you compete on more than one horse or pony, you will receive points per horse or pony.
- Your top 5 classes will be taken into account for the Club Supreme Champion. This will also be on a per horse or pony basis.

Points are awarded as follows: (In a case where a non-member is placed higher than a MDRC member, the points will move down to the next placed MDRC member.)

1<sup>st</sup> = 8 points                      2<sup>nd</sup> = 6 points                      3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points                      4<sup>th</sup> = 2 points
